Dear Woodturner,

What follows is a page with some information about the classes, as well as a registration form, liability release, driving directions and lodging and transportation information.

Tuition cost for the three-day workshop is \$500. A \$200 deposit is required to hold your space. The remaining \$300 is due upon arrival. The deposit is refundable up until 45 days before the class begins. This allows enough time for those on the waiting list to make their travel arrangements. Please return your deposit with your registration form and make checks payable to Trent Bosch.

Current dates with availability are available on my website or by contacting me. Workshops are scheduled throughout the year and are held at my personal studios in Fort Collins Colorado.

What follows is a list of items you may want to bring along (all are optional): Notebook or sketchpad (filled with clippings or sketches of ideas you are interested in exploring), 1/2" bowl gouge, 3/8" bowl gouge, hollowing turning tools, any tool that may be giving you trouble, a few pieces that you have turned - some you like and some you don't (actual pieces or slides are fine), anything else you deem appropriate.

If possible plan to arrive so we can meet Thursday evening at about 7:00pm to set up and get you familiar with the layout and where my studio is located. We can also discuss what you expect to accomplish during the workshop.

A typical day will look something like this although things tend to be very relaxed. We will meet at my house each morning at 7:30am for breakfast and get out to work by about 8:00am. We'll work until noon, have lunch and hit it again at 1:00pm until about 5:00pm when I will head to the house to help get dinner ready. Dinner is usually served at about 6:00pm. A small warning, my family consists of me my wife (Sari) and my three young children (Kailee, Sienna, Treden). They are fun and as you would expect dinner will not be very formal.

You can expect to learn various techniques for bowls and hollow forms as well as numerous ways to manipulate wood into the desired effect.

Specialties: Vessels Of Illusion, green wood turning, drying techniques for green wood, carving and surface treatments, making your own tools, how to generate new ideas from life experiences, finding your voice in this medium, as well as how and where to get started selling your work.

Why Choose This Workshop: Trent has been demonstrating and teaching woodturning for many years. His approach to teaching is very friendly and direct. The learning environment is one of patience and understanding. If you want to take your woodturning to the next level, give it a try.

Details: You will be provided with all the wood you can turn and more. A wide variety of the best equipment is available for your use. Meals, day 1 breakfast through day 3 lunch, with Trent and his family will also be provided, at no extra cost. A list of nearby accommodations will be provided upon registration. You will need to make your own reservations.

Where: Workshops are located at Trent's personal studio in Fort Collins Colorado.

Tentative workshop schedule

Every day you can expect to see few short demos on techniques that you can try that day. The idea I have about hands on workshops is to really let the class take shape with what you have an interest in. Here is a sample schedule of topics we may discuss.

Day 1

- Turning open forms
- Getting comfortable with the 1/2" swept back grind gouge
- Different grinds to minimize sanding
- Wood selection (what to look for and why)
- Using Green Wood
- Drying options (Kiln, Air, and other ideas)
- How to cut the wood for best figure

Day 2

- Enclosed forms (Vessels of Illusion etc.)
- Tools for Hollowing
- Judging wall thickness (Look, Listen, and feel)
- Form (what is good form?)
- Turning pieces that will be carved on (leaving enough wood)

Day 3

- Wood Manipulation
 - Bending wood
 - Carving Wood
 - Sandblasting wood
- Surface treatments
 - Ways to achieve the desired effect in your work
 - Color, texture, etc.
- Finishing (lots of options)
- Whatever area you want to explore further
- Slides of work if applicable
- Look and discuss work created and techniques used

Other Topics (any day)

- Use of other materials in your work (metal plastic etc.)
- Making your own tools
- How to generate new ideas for your work (from life experiences or other interests etc.)
- Finding your own voice in woodturning
- How and where to get started selling your work

The whole idea is for this to be fun and educational so I am sure we will have a blast. I am very laid back and willing to do whatever you want. It will be a good time for all.

Trent Bosch Studios Directions to Studio and Home

From Denver International take E -470 north towards Fort Collins (a toll way, 2 tolls \$1.75 each) follow that to I-25 north out of Denver.

Follow I-25 for about 50 miles to the Owl Canyon Road Exit 281. (It is the exit right after the Wellington Exit and about 10 miles north of Fort Collins)

Turn Left on Owl Canyon Road (County Road 70). Follow that road 4-5 miles to the first stop sign.

You'll be at County Road 15. Turn left onto County Road 15.

Go exactly one mile to County Road 68. Turn Right. (It is hard to see this road because of a little hill in the road. There is a sign for a crossroad right before it.)

Go one more mile to County Road 17. Turn Left.

We are the second driveway on the left hand side. The address is 10520 North County Road 17. The house and studio set a little way back from the road.
